Annual Report 2024-25

NEW ACADEMIC YEAR 2024-25

A staff meeting was held to prepare the staff members for the challenges of the academic year 2024-25 on May 27, 2024. The timetable and duty allotment were distributed to the respective teachers. Departmental meetings were also held in the afternoon to chalk out plans for the upcoming academic year.

A **teachers' seminar** was conducted on May 28, under the aegis of the Ratnasagar Publishers on the topic "*Innovative and effective teaching practices*". The keynote speaker was Sri Reji K Samuel who enlightened the teachers on ways and means to make their teaching practice highly effective.

Interactive panel training was offered to the teachers on May 29. It highlighted the role and importance of AI in education. In the post-lunch session, Entab software training was provided.

Another teachers' seminar was conducted on May 30. The topic this time was "Path Maker: Teacher beyond the classroom". The seminar was led by Sri Manoj Govind who shed light on the teacher's multitasking role.

Departmental meetings were held on May 31 to finalize the year plan. **Syllabus presentations** were done for the first unit by teachers from each department. School Principal Dr Roy PK intervened to offer suitable corrections wherever needed. The post-lunch session was devoted to rehearsing the opening ceremony for the morrow.

A **coordinators' meeting** with their section staff took place on June 01 to discuss plans for the new academic year. Class teachers, aided by their assistant teachers, decorated their respective classrooms for the mega reopening the next day.

The *inauguration of the academic year 2024-25* took place on June 03, and the theme for the new year was "*Conquering new horizons of learning*". The lamp lighting ceremony was followed by readings from the sacred scriptures of various religions.

After the theme song by the school choir, school manager Rev Fr Jose Parappillil addressed the gathering. During the meeting, a formal farewell was offered to former school administrator Rev Fr Baby Elanjimattathil. His successor Rev Fr Binod Puthanpurackal was welcomed to the school in a dignified manner. New staff members then introduced themselves to the school assembly. A message tailored to the occasion was delivered by Dr Roy and ended the function with the national anthem.

World Environment Day was celebrated on June 05, under the theme "Land restoration, desertification and drought resilience". The Pachap campaign set up by the school got rolling with the campaign Bhoomikkoru Kuda, highlighting tree plantation as the need of the hour.

Sri Aby Emmanuel, Secretary of the Meenachil River Protection Council, inaugurated the function. Dr Roy administered an oath that affirmed the school's responsibility to reduce pollution, conserve resources and protect biodiversity.

Sri A M Sunil, Chirakkulam South Residents Association Joint Secretary, received a sapling from Sri Aby Emmanuel. Simultaneously, Fr Kelvin Olikkunnel, Fr Binod Puthanpurackal, Smt Jaimol John and Sri Nebi Abraham received and distributed saplings to students and auxiliary staff members.

The school's commitment to the preservation of nature was highlighted in the planting of some saplings on the school ground.

Merit Day Laureate 2024 was held on June 08, marking the celebration of merit and the inauguration of Grade XI this year. Fr Jose Parappillil lighted the lamp and delivered the presidential address. Dr Indira Rajan released the school annual and presented awards to school toppers and winners of various competitive exams. Other category awards were handed over by Fr Jose, Dr Roy, and Fr Kelvin. The school choir rendered the national anthem marking the end of the programme.

Addiction Awareness Session was conducted on June 08, to create awareness of the evils of drug addiction. Collaborating in this project was Caritas Hospital. Dr Deepthi Madhu, chief quality and HIC Officer at Caritas Hospital, served as the resource person. Fr Kelvin presented her with a memento as a token of appreciation.

Rabies Special Assembly was held on June 13, to spread awareness of rabies. Sri Rajeev S R, Junior Health Inspector; Sri Jithin Jose, and Sri Dileep V.T. shared their valuable insights on rabies and safeguards against it.
